- Tidal range: 3.0 – 3.5 m

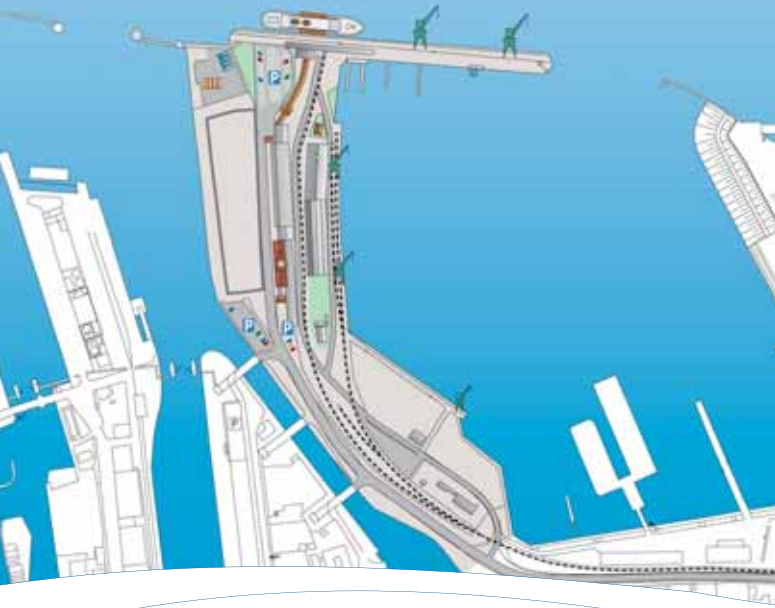
Quay facilities:
